(NEW) Summer Games – Opening Ceremony Survey – Respond by 6:00pm June 21

On Wednesday, June 14, each Area Director and Summer Games Head of Delegation should have received an email from Mike Czarnowsky regarding the brief survey collecting information related to Opening Ceremony at Summer Games. This includes number of expected delegation members attending, special seating needs, names of the 4 (maximum) athletes and 1 coach/teammate to march in the parade representing their delegation, and nominations for athletes and coaches to participate in the Opening Ceremony (oaths, torch, etc.)

The deadline for responses of 6:00pm on Wednesday, June 21 is a firm deadline as that information will be used in the Games Management Team Meeting that evening and several other games-related decisions will be handled that evening and the next day so we can have up-to-date and accurate info for the Head of Delegation meeting on Thursday night.

Any Area/delegation for which a response is not received by the 6:00pm June 21 deadline will not have designated seating and will not have representatives march in the parade. They will be acknowledged by the emcees from the stage.

Jake Novick:

We are excited to welcome Jake Novick to the Special Olympics Maryland Staff in the new role of Unified Recreation Manager!

He is joining us from Towson University where he just earned his master's degree while working as the Graduate Assistant for Competitive Sports with Towson Campus Recreation. During his assistantship, he played a leadership role in the development and implementation of SOMD's four unified intramural seasons at Towson.

Jake was a candidate for the Metro Region Director position and through his many interviews with our staff, it was clear that his knowledge of campus recreation programs and experience starting a unified intramural program can provide an immediate positive impact in the growth of our programs. The role of Unified Recreation Manager is a new position for our organization, and one that will be supported by Unified Champion Schools funding. It was a position that we had planned to post and hire over the summer, but with an exceptionally strong candidate identified and vetted, we chose to expedite the process.

To better facilitate the life-long participation of athletes and unified teammates, Special Olympics North America has identified improved integration between school and community programs as a priority of the Unified Champion Schools grant. Special Olympics Maryland was selected as one of the state programs to participate in their School Community Program Integration pilot, and through this, we have identified the growth of new models of unified play and competition as an important way to both grow our program and keep athletes and unified teammates engaged.

As Unified Recreation Manager, Jake will report directly to Jeff and will continue to grow existing Unified Intramural programs with Towson and Mount St. Mary's while establishing new programs with both university and community partners. The Unified Recreation Manager will work collaboratively with Region Directors and Sports Directors to implement new program models for play and competition as we work to engage more athletes and unified teammates.

We look forward to Jacob's positive contributions in support of our athletes and unified teammates! Please join me in welcoming him to the team.

Jake will be at Summer Games with Jeff, so as you see him, please welcome Jake to Special Olympics Maryland.

Summer Games Updates

We want to apologize that we (okay Mike) has had to delay opening Summer Games in GMS for Areas to do their data entry. It is open now and memos will go out on Monday, May 22, related to entry status and process as well as housing. Due to the delay in providing some of this information, we will be extending two deadlines related to Summer Games:

Missing Forms and Certifications Deadline is now Tuesday, May 30, 2023 Competition Registration Deadline is now Monday, June 5, 2023

Also, as noted previously, if you wish SOMD HQ to "advance" your entries and scores from a previous competition in GMS (even one which was rained out), it will only work if you have NOT already entered them into their events in Summer Games in GMS. When doing an advancement, if the system sees that the athlete is already in the 50M Freestyle, it will ignore anything in that athlete's record in Summer Games related to the 50M Freestyle (i.e., it will NOT update the score/time).

Forms for ALL Training Participants Must Be Submitted to SOMD HQ - Even Those Not Going to "States"

Just a friendly reminder that forms and certifications for everyone participating in your sports training programs must be valid and up-to-date through the end of the season (June 25 for Summer Games sports) AND must be submitted to SOMD HQ even if they are not attending the state championship. We've found that at the end of each season there are still several individuals who participated in various Area programs but whose medical, volunteer application, CDW, etc. were never submitted to SOMD HQ. Please be certain to submit those forms and certifications for ALL of your training program participants.
