# (NEW) 2024 SOMD Winter Games Updates

We're looking forward to an exciting winter sports training season and an even more exciting Winter Games. Here are a few updates:

- 1. <u>Event Guide (Preliminary Draft)</u> We have posted a <u>preliminary draft</u> of the 2024 Winter Games Event Guide Winter Games Coach Resource Page (CRP). The information in this preliminary draft should be considered "tentative" but this will provide helpful information for planning purposes, informing athletes/coaches/families of event basics, etc.. Please feel free to share this reference with other prospective delegation members and interested parties. The "final" version of the WG Event Guide will be posted at the same location by February 12.

- 2. Winter Games Is Open in GMS Thank you to everyone for completing their training registrations by the Thursday evening deadline. We've advanced into Winter Games 2024 everyone listed as participating in training for either Alpine Skiing or Snowshoeing. You likely have also already received an email from Dottie Rush regarding who has been advanced and any issues with missing forms which are due by January 15, 2024. You will receive a separate message from Elizabeth Kramer or Casey Collins regarding coaches who have an issue with their Sport Coach certification for their respective sport (once we know who all the coaches are).

Your GMS person can access the games in GMS and should do the following as soon as possible so that we can be sure that everyone is included in the appropriate communications:

- A. Designate who is serving as the *Head of Delegation* and who is the *Head Coach* for each of the sports in which you have competitors
- B. Make sure that each person has the correct role indicated for them, most particularly your head coaches, general coaches and assistant coaches (people were advanced with whatever role that had most recently in the overall training games in GMS, which may not have been as a coach.

Your GMS person should also complete the following by the Competition Registration Deadline (Monday, February 5):

- 1. Delete anyone in your delegation who is currently listed in Winter Games but who will not actually be attending Winter Games.
- 2. For each Athlete and Unified® Partner, enter them in the events in which your coaches expect that they will compete at Winter Games.
  - a. Do NOT enter them into any of the "time trial" events SOMD will handle that
  - b. Do NOT enter an entry score that will be captured at the required time trials which will be held on-site at Winter Games (mostly on Sunday of the Games)
  - c. For any Unified teams and Relay Teams:
    - i. Create the team using the XX-Lname1/Lname2/Lname3/Lname4 standard format for naming such teams
    - ii. Add the competitors to their respective teams
  - d. Coaches will be able to adjust levels and events to some degree as the Winter Games approach as well as on-site following the time trials (since conditions and slopes can have a significant impact on which events work best for a given competitor)
- 3. You will NOT be able to add anyone to your Winter Games delegation in GMS (your GMS credentials do not permit you to do that).

- 3. Opening Ceremony: Banner Carriers

   The Winter Games Management Team (GMT) is asking for each Area Program attending the Winter Games to submit the two individuals who will represent the Area Program during the Opening Ceremony. These two individuals (and only two individuals) will need to report early to a location near, or within the McHenry Lodge to check-in for the reppresentative parade of delegations. These individuals will be carrying in the banner that represents each Area Program. Please send an email with your Area name, the names of the two (2) individuals and their roles (Athlete, Unified® Partner, etc.) to Steve Bennett via email at: <a href="mailto:sbennett@somd.org">sbennett@somd.org</a> no later than 1:00pm February 12, 2024.
- 4. <u>Opening Ceremony: Oaths, Pledge of Allegiance, Torch</u> The Winter Games Management Team (GMT) is asking for Area Programs that are interested in nominating individuals (athletes or coaches) for the following opportunities for the Opening Ceremony at Winter Games:
  - a. Athlete Oath (athlete)
  - b. Coaches Oath (must be a fully certified/credentialed coach for their sport)
  - c. Pledge of Allegiance (athlete)
  - d. Torch Bearer (athlete)

NOTE: These individuals will need to be in attendance for the Games and arrive early to the Opening Ceremony. They will be seated on the Opening Ceremony stage, not with the rest of their delegation. These cannot be the same people you have designated as a banner carrier.

# (NEW) GMS Clean-Up - Games from 2016-2018 To Be Archived and Deleted on 01/15/2024

On Monday, January 15, 2024, we will be doing some clean-up of GMS to make searches easier (and potentially quicker). Most notably we will be archiving and then deleting ALL games from 2016 through 2018. The archive will be available in case it is necessary for us to access the info from any of these games. No changes will be made at this time for any games from 2019 (the last complete pre-pandemic year) through to the present day.

We <u>will NOT</u> delete any of the "census games" or "training registration games" which will remain available to all GMS users (similar to what is currently available for 2012-2015).

We're giving you this "heads up" so you are not surprised when we make the change. Also, if there is some reason that you would want to print or export any information from those earlier games before we execute the archive/deletion. (Note: To date no one has ever requested access to any of the previously archived games which stretch back to 1999 – so we don't anticipate this causing any inconvenience for Area programs.)
