Hagerstown to the competition sites -- 30 minutes away. Even with new transportation and communications challenges the 2011 Winter Games went off with very few complications. The weather, of course, was another story!

With temperatures near 50 degrees in the days leading up to Winter Games, Whitetail Resort went out of its way to make the snowshoeing venue the best it could be. The night before competition, they moved snow from up on the hill to the race course, to give the athletes the best snow possible. Rain on Monday delayed competition but all races were completed by the end of the day.

Athletes Russell Bucci, Michael Nahrgang, Melody Chase and first year snowshoer Jason Swift competed in the 50 and 100 meter races. Michelle Johnson. 
