After 3 days of varying conditions, from spring to winter, our St. Mary's athletes are triumphant once again. Our success should be attributed to our outstanding coaches, partners and athletes. Tom Emery, our local dry-land training coach, who is a former ski instructor from the mid-west, led our local training sessions to increase our athletes' endurance and fitness. We also want to thank the Boone Family from Leonardtown as a first year addition to our ski and snowshoe training program, getting our athletes ready. Tom worked with our newest bi-skier, Talea Ingmire and her brother, Taylor Ingmire, to achieve 2 great gold medal runs. The Two-Top adapted program at Whitetail and Tom helped greatly in the success of the Ingmire team. Our veteran mono-skier, Kayla Woolridge, is once again the fastest skier in the novice event and made 2 clean runs. She is looking forward to the intermediate course next year.

Coach Bret Bucci worked with a new skier this year, Tasha Ingmire, in her novice event. Tasha made strides in her success during these Games by completing 2 good runs in the novice course. We are very proud of her. Our thanks to Bret for all of his patience with our beginners over the years. Coach Steve Rinaldo and Brian Tierney trained with our novice skiers, Andrea Brown (2 golds) and Justin Fowler (2 golds). Their progress will help to move these 2 skiers to the intermediate events next year. Our partner and coach, Lucas Garner, paired with Phyllis White, Kegan Zimmerman, Jason Swift and Joshua Fondren went a little higher on the mountain with a more challenging run. Phyllis competed with a large heat for Int. Giant Slalom. She did her best and placed 5th. In her Unified Team event with partner Sharon Fondren, she

missed a gate and received a participation ribbon. Jason Swift, an athlete who is soon moving from St. Mary's, held his own in Int. Giant Slalom with a 5th place. He was triumphant in the Unified event with partner Lilly Emley (who struggled with being sick during the weekend) and finished the race for the gold. Kegan Zimmerman won 3rd in Int Giant Slalom and then skied like a champion in his Int Slalom race for a 2nd. Joshua Fondren was in the Int. groupings and placed 5th and 3rd in his races. The team of coaches/partners Annah and Marc Rinaldo set out for the Games with the advanced athletes, Larry Mills, Thomas Smith, Jimmy Hawkins, Justin Thompson, Joey Owens and partner Courtney Bucci, and came back down winning 3 golds, 3 silvers, and 2 bronze medals and 2 fourth place ribbons. Training at the MOG by Karen Wathen

St. Mary's County Special Olympics has partnered with The Medically Oriented Gym (M.O.G.) at Gateau Physical Therapy & Sports Medicine to train 19 athletes in their state-of-the-art facility for the upcoming 2014 Special Olympics USA Games. Exercise Physiologist, Keri Ramey, assisted groups of athletes over a short period of time to become adept in the use of exercise machines for their respective training needs according to their sport. The athletes then are able to work out at the M.O.G. with a chaperone or coach who has also been trained on the machines. Ms. Ramey has continued to oversee the training and provides additional assistance to them.

"It has been a pleasure working with these athletes. They are giving it their all during our workout sessions together. They all have different goals to reach and it feels good to be a part of that," said Ms. Ramey. The M.O.G. offers a full range of exercise options for all people. Each member receives an initial assessment from the exercise physiologist who then provides them with an individualized exercise program. Assessments are done every 90 days thereafter. Their mission is to deliver a level of service that the member never expected, every day. They are committed to assist all people in obtaining a healthy and fit lifestyle, and have a variety of programs to meet everyone's needs.

The athletes representing St. Mary's competing in individual sports during the 2014 USA Games are: Russell Bucci (bocce); Mary Herbert (bowling); Rachel Hicks (bowling); Amanda Lowe (cycling); April Towler (golf); Tyeshia Holt (track); Khadisha Young (track); Jason Swift (track); and Matt Dobson (track). St. Mary's Special Olympics Flag Football team will also be represented within Team Maryland by athletes:
